

SCHOOL DISTRICT VOTING

Qualifications for Voting

Each voter of the District shall sign in prior to casting his or her ballot, be a registered voter with Broadalbin-Perth Central School District, and must meet the following qualifications:

1. A citizen of the United States
2. At least 18 years old
3. A resident within the district for a period of at least 30 days preceding the date of the vote.

A person need not be a taxpayer to vote.

Voting on the Budget and Election of Board of Education Members

The vote on the budget and the election of Board members will take place on the statewide voting date established by the State Education Department between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. prevailing time, with pre-registration required at sites and times designated by the Board of Education.

1. The ballot shall list the names of candidates who have filed petitions. Ballot order will be determined by random selection.
2. Provision shall be made on the ballot for write-in candidates.
3. Citizens shall vote on the proposed budget in its entirety only.
