

**REQUIRED IMMUNIZATION**

Required immunization effective November 3, 2004:

- Three (3) doses of Diphtheria containing Toxoid vaccine for entry into PreK and for any student entering into New York State for the first time
- Three (3) doses of Polio vaccine for entry into PreK and for any student entering into New York State for the first time
- One (1) dose of Mumps vaccine for entry into PreK
- One (1) dose of Rubella vaccine for entry into PreK
- One (1) dose of Measles vaccine (for students born prior to 1985 and for Pre-K students)
- Two (2) doses of Measles vaccine and one (1) dose each of mumps and rubella for any entering K-12 students (preferably as MMR)
- Three (3) doses of Hepatitis B vaccine (for students Pre-K through grade 6)
- Two (2) dose series or three (3) dose series for Hepatitis B for students grades 7-11
- One (1) dose of Varicella for Pre-K if born on or after January 1, 2000
- One (1) dose of Varicella for Kindergarten students born on or after January 1, 1998
- Three (3) doses of Haemophilus influenza type B (Hib) before 15 months of age for Pre-K or one (1) dose if given on or after 15 months of age

Required immunization effective January 1, 2005:

- One (1) dose of Varicella for students born on or after January 1, 1994, and who are enrolled in or repeating the 6<sup>th</sup> grade

Required immunization effective September 1, 2007

- Three (3) doses of Tetanus Toxoid-Containing Vaccine and Pertussis Vaccine (DTaP, DTP) for entry into PreK if born on or after January 1, 2005
- One (1) dose of Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis Booster (Tdap) for any student born on or after January 1, 1994 and enrolling in 6<sup>th</sup> grade or comparable age-level special education school or program and who are 11 years of age or older
