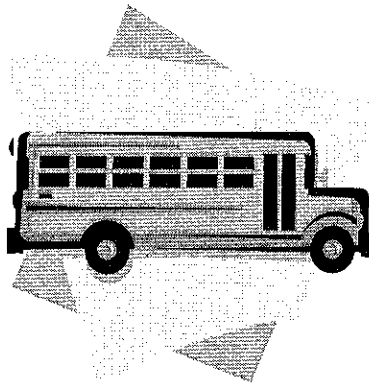

- 5 Bottom Pocket Folders of any Color

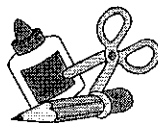

### Mrs. Gregory - Fourth Grade Supply List

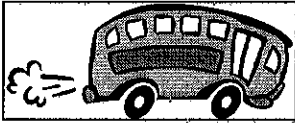
- Pencil Case (small soft one that will fit in the desk)

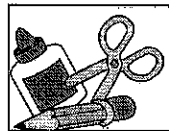

#### **Homeroom**

**No Trapper Keepers or large binders. Please label all supplies with student name.**



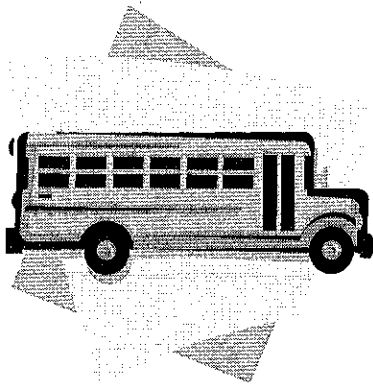

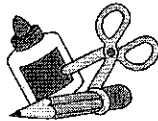




### Mrs. Ratajczak – Fourth Grade Supply List
